COVID-19 CLINIC INFORMATION SHEET

Baptist Health Medical Center-Little Rock Infusion Clinic

If you've recently been diagnosed with COVID-19 and have mild-moderate symptoms, you may have a new treatment option: REGEN-COV. REGEN-COV is an investigational medicine used for the treatment of COVID-19 in non-hospitalized patients who are at high risk for developing severe COVID-19 symptoms or the need for hospitalization.

If you have risk factors for severe disease and have tested positive for COVID-19 and have had symptoms for less than 10 days, it is possible you could be a candidate for this infusion.

RISK FACTORS FOR SEVERE DISEASE:

- ☐ Overweight (Body Mass Index > 25)
- ☐ Pregnancy
- ☐ Sickle Cell Disease
- ☐ Chronic Kidney Disease
- ☐ Diabetes mellitus
- ☐ Immunosuppressive Disease (Cancer, Autoimmune Disease, etc)
- ☐ Currently Receiving immunosuppressive Treatment
- ☐ 65 years of age or older
- ☐ Cardiovascular disease (high blood pressure, heart disease, etc)
- ☐ COPD/other chronic respiratory disease (asthma, etc)
- ☐ Neurodevelopmental Disorder
- ☐ Medical related dependence (tracheostomy, PEG, etc)

EXCLUSIONS:

Any patient <18 years of age should be referred to Arkansas Children's Hospital
REGEN COV is not authorized for patients with an increased O2 requirement.
